Glen Conway Riley was born in Sydney on 19 April 1949 and completed his secondary education at Merrylands High School, NSW. Glenn was a competitive swimmer. Before entering the Army as a National Serviceman he was employed as a Section Manager by Woolworths, Australia. Whilst at OTU Glen reached the rank of Colour Sergeant as a Company Quartermaster Sergeant. Glen graduated with Class 4/69 on 15 April 1970, was allocated to the Royal Australian Infantry Corps and posted to 5 RAR in Australia.



Having extended his NS, Glen served in Vietnam with the 1st Australian Reinforcement Unit (1 ARU) from 22 July to 1 September 1971 and then as the D&E Platoon Commander with the 1st Australian Logistics Support Group (1

ALSG) at Vung Tau until 9 March 1972 before returning to Australia and being posted back to 5 RAR in Australia. Glen discharged from the Army sometime after 31 March 1972.

Jim Berry (1/70) advised that the Australian Embassy in Thailand had contacted relatives of Glen and advised them that Glen has passed away on 15 November 2015 in a Phuket hospital.
