Glenn Conway Riley was born in Sydney on 19 April 1949. He completed his secondary education at Merrylands High School, NSW. Glenn was a competitive swimmer. Before entering the Army as a National Serviceman he was working as a Section Manager with Woolworths. Whilst at OTU he attained the rank of Colour Sergeant as a Company Quartermaster Sergeant. He was allocated to the Royal Australian Infantry and posted to 5 RAR in Australia. Having extended his NS, Glen served in Vietnam with the 1st Australian Reinforcement Unit (1 ARU) and then the 1st Australian Logistics Support Group (1 ALSG) at Vung Tau before being posted back to 5 RAR in Australia. Glen discharged from the Army sometime after 31 March 1972. The Australian Embassy in Thailand contacted Glen's relatives advising he passed away on 15 November 2015 in a Phuket hospital.
